Tailgate Throw-Down Contest Rules

- 1) Cooking ingredients must include:
 - a. Jambalaya / Pastalaya– 30pds meat and 10pds rice/pasta
 - b. Ribs – 10 slabs
 - c. Brisquet – 40 pounds
 - d. Chicken – 50 qtrs
- 2) Cooks must furnish own equipment, utensils and supplies
- 3) Food becomes property of WHS Panther Tailgate Event. Pots or containers will not be available until completion of the fair. You may place in disposable containers/ice chest etc. Cooks will be furnished one (1) hinged plate for sample for contest judging.
- 4) Sample plates will be picked up by the event team
- 5) Cooks will be allowed to cooking booths and leave one vehicle there while cooking in the assigned booth.
- 6) Trash barrels are provided to dispose of all trash. We ask you leave your cooking area clean and free of trash.
- 7) Grease containers will be provided for used cooking oil. Absolutely no cooking oil is to be poured on the grounds or in drains.
- 8) Electrical must be provided by cooking teams, please use quiet generators.

The contest will consist of two divisions: a school division and an open division. Awards will go to 1st and 2nd place teams in both divisions
